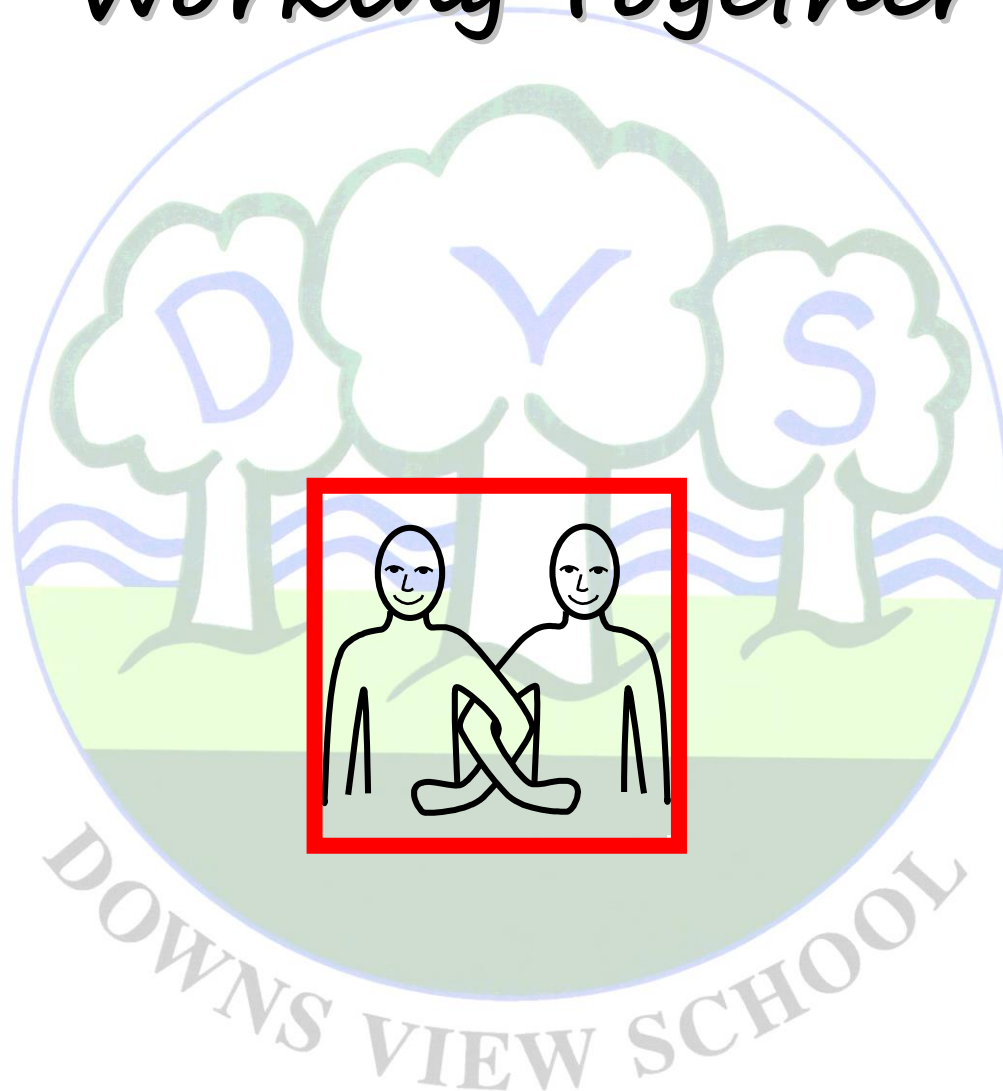

- **To work with parents, professionals and the community as joint partners in the education of our pupils**

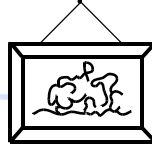
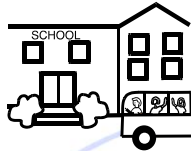
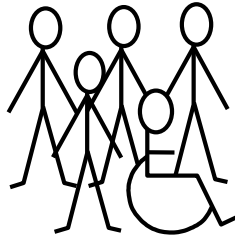
The School Will

- Keep parents informed about their child through home school books, newsletters, reports and personal contact

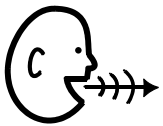
